This is an opportunity to do some good while Christmas, Holiday, and other gift shopping. Below is information about the ten foundations we will be supporting:

Church World Service (CWS):

CWS is cooperative ministry of 36 Protestant, Orthodox and Anglican denominations providing sustainable self-help and development, disaster relief and refugee assistance in more than 80 countries.

Habitat for Humanity (HFH):

HPH helps provide affordable houses for economically deprived persons in both the United States and other countries. Short term volunteers and donated materials minimize construction costs. In addition, the recipients of the houses must contribute at least 500 hours of “sweat equity” labor toward the construction of their houses. Low or no interest loans through HFH help make the ownership possible.

Heart of the Valley (Services for Seniors, Inc.)

Heart of the Valley is a non-profit, volunteer agency committed to facilitating, advocating and supporting independent living for seniors in West Santa Clara County. Examples of in-home services are; yard work, handyman projects, computer support and paperwork assistance. There are no fees for any services provided.

Heifer Project:

Heifer International’s mission is to end hunger and poverty while caring for the Earth. For 70 years Heifer International has provided livestock and environmentally sound agricultural training to improve the lives of those who struggle daily for reliable sources of income. Heifer is currently working in more than 30 countries, including the U.S., to help families and communities become more self-reliant.

Second Harvest Food Bank:

Second Harvest Food Bank has provided local solutions to hunger since 1974. Your giving will help feed children, families and seniors in Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties.

United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR): UMCOR responds to dozens of unsung disasters every year. UMCOR is there when the news cameras are not. In short term, UMCOR steps in to ease human suffering. In long term, UMCOR works in accompaniment with local partners toward capacity building and Disaster Risk Reduction.

Wildlife Center of Silicon Valley:

The Wildlife Center of Silicon Valley is a rescue and rehabilitation facility that help over 5,000 sick, injured and orphaned wild animals a year. Their education programs foster a positive coexistence between the general public and wildlife, and through all their activities, encourage an interest and concern for wildlife and conservation issues.

Stop Hunger Now:

Stop Hunger Now is a non-profit international hunger-relief organization that coordinates the distribution of dried food packets to those in need around the world. Your gift to Stop Hunger Now will enable CUMC to host meal-packing events for the community.
